Eligibility

- Open to any undergraduate and graduate students, and postdoctoral researchers
- Open to any faculty/principal investigators/staff

Abstract Requirements

- Must be no more than **300** words, not including references
- References and additional resources can be included on a separate page. The title of the abstract will be printed in the program booklet.
- Should include a list of authors and co-authors, along with their department affiliations (not considered part of the 300-word limit)
- Double-spaced
- Arial or Times New Roman Font
- 12-point type size

1. The following abstract structure is recommended but not mandated

- Identification of Problem and Significance
- Approach/Methods
- Results
- Conclusions

2. Considerations and Notes

• After submission of the abstract, the Research Expo Team will contact you with next steps regarding printing and presentation guideline and expectations.

3. Poster Guidelines and What to Expect

- You will be responsible for printing your own poster. You will be given 36" of space on the screen flex board
- You may create your poster in 36" x 24" or 24" x 36". Other sizes will be welcome with committee permission. Submit your request at the time of abstract submission.

Oral presentation information and requirements

Give a talk ($12 \min + 3 \min$ questions) in person at the assigned date, time, and location.

Presentation guidelines

- All presenters should use PowerPoint to create their presentation (.pptx format).
- Widescreen projectors will be used in all meeting rooms. PowerPoints should be formatted in 16:9 aspect ratio.
- For presentations created on an Apple computer, please be aware of the following:
- Videos: QuickTime formats such as .mov are not native to Windows computers. Please convert videos to .mp4.
- Animations: Use simple entry animation effects such as: fly in/out, appear and dissolve.
- Fonts: Use common fonts. Pre-installed and custom fonts will not translate properly on a Windows machine.
- Keynote: If creating your presentation in Keynote, please Export as .pptx.

Deadline to submit abstracts is March 15th, 2025.

- Applicant notifications will be sent by March 25th or after the extended abstract deadline.
- Individuals will need to be available between 7:00 8:00 am on Wednesday, May 14th, 2025, to set up their poster in the Atrium of the Environmental Science Building. *Poster take down will be between 2-4pm on Thursday May*, 15th.
